The Southern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (SSRAA) has an opening for the **Hatchery Manger** at the Neets Bay Hatchery.

Under the supervision of the Production Manager the Neets Bay Hatchery Manager directs all aspects of hatchery operations. Neets Bay is a remote salmon hatchery located approximately 30 air miles north of Ketchikan, Alaska operating as a multi-species facility incorporating both freshwater and saltwater fish culture with a permanent staff consisting of an assistant manager, maintenance manager, three fish culture positions, two maintenance positions, and up to 10 seasonal staff.

There are approximately 140 million Chum and 3.2 million Coho cultured at the Neets Bay facility. The position requires living on site year round in furnished rental housing. Provided utilities and remote benefits include but are not limited to: weekly mail and supply flights, satellite internet, and monthly hotel accommodations in Ketchikan.

The ideal candidate must exhibit the ability to lead by developing healthy working relationships throughout the corporation, sharing knowledge and skills in the process. Experience must include a solid foundation in hatchery operations including gamete collection, incubation operations, fish husbandry, saltwater rearing and egg/fry transport operations. Demonstrated ability to successfully lead a workforce. Excellent communication skills and an understanding of facility and equipment maintenance. A minimum four years of experience in production scale hatcheries with at least assistant manager level experience and a two-year degree in fish culture or related field is required. Work experience may be considered in lieu of degree.

Salary range starts \$73,739 or greater **depending on experience**. The benefit package includes but is not limited to: health, dental, life and long term disability insurance, and a competitive retirement plan. SSRAA is an equal opportunity employer.
