Southern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (SSRAA) is recruiting for full-time seasonal maintenance technician(s) at the Neets Bay Hatchery, a remote hatchery located approximately 30 air miles from Ketchikan, Alaska. The Neets Bay Hatchery program includes approximately 140 million chum salmon and 3.5 million coho salmon. This position requires living on site in a furnished bunkhouse. Provided benefits include but are not limited to: weekly mail and supply flights, satellite internet, satellite tv, and groceries. Work consists of maintenance and repairs associated with 9 residential buildings, a bunkhouse, a shop/office building, a hatchery building, rolling stock, various boats and outboards, a hydro-electric generator and two diesel generators, a large dock and multiple netpen complexes, multiple barges as well as other infrastructure associated with a small community.

The ideal candidate can develop healthy working relationships with co-workers and have a willingness to learn and share knowledge and skills. Some experience in construction and/or repair is required. Boating experience is a plus. The job requires the ability to lift, carry, push, or pull 50lbs or more repeatedly, work outdoors in inclement weather or inside around cold running water.
