This facility is a remote salmon hatchery located on Etolin Island, approx. 30 air miles from Wrangell. The position will begin mid-July and last until the end of October.

The primary duties of this position are to assist permanent staff in the collection, and incubation of up to 100 million chum salmon eggs. Incumbents will be expected to work in a cold, wet, dark environment and must be able to repeatedly lift at least 50lbs.
