Lead Maintenance Technician

Southern Southeast Regional Aquaculture Association (SSRAA) is recruiting for full-time Lead Maintenance Technician at the Neets Bay Hatchery a remote hatchery located approximately 30 air miles from Ketchikan, Alaska. The Neets Bay Hatchery program includes approximately 140 million chum salmon and 3.5 million coho salmon. This position requires living on site in furnished subsidized rental housing. Utilities include but are not limited to: weekly mail and supply flights, satellite internet, and R&R hotel accommodations in Ketchikan. This position requires workplace flexibility to include maintenance duties at the hatchery and include some fish culture duties, as needed.

The ideal candidate can develop healthy working relationships with co-workers and have a willingness to learn and share knowledge and skills. Desired maintenance skills include knowledge of: carpentry, welding, plumbing, basic electrical, mechanical, maintaining preventative maintenance records, use of hand and power tools, and project planning. The job requires the ability to lift, carry, push, or pull 50lbs or more repeatedly, work in inclement weather, and inside around cold running water.
